Jack Redding, President and Kristen Mitchell, New Product Sales and Marketing had the opportunity to speak with former U.S House Speaker Newt Gingrich at the World Congress IT Summit in Washington DC on December 10, 2008. Highlighted Feature: Conditional AAOE

Additional functionality has been added to the Ask at Order Entry (AAOE) function. This additional functionality is called 'Conditional AAOE'. Conditional AAOE are additional questions that are presented to the end user based upon the answer to the 'Parent' question.

1. An example of a Conditional AAOE would be the question 'Source of Specimen?'

If 'Fluid' is selected as the answer another set of questions would be presented asking 'Type of Fluid?' with another set of answers.

If Pleural Fluid is selected as the answer, another set of questions would be presented asking Right or Left.

- These 'Conditional AAOE' are built using the Admin Mode / Ask at Order Entry function. The 'Parent' question, and the answer that is required to present the 'Child' question, are defined in the Create Question Templates function. In the example above:

'Source of Specimen?' is the Parent of the question 'Type of Fluid?'. The answer that will trigger the question 'Type of Fluid?' is "Fluid". 'Type of Fluid' is the parent of the question 'Right or Left Lung'. The answer that will trigger the question 'Right or Left Lung' is "Pleural Fluid".

Highlights of changes coming in Version 8.12

- Added ability to direct a requisition to a Foreign Lab by pulling insurance data from PMS via a bridge.
- Added additional programming to speed up patient queries.
- Added Advanced User tracking to correctly track hours user is logged on in the Audit Report.
- Updated ABN checking
 - Added check for Never Covered diagnosis codes
 - Set to display both Frequency Covered and Limited Coverage flags on the Order Review screen when applicable.

- Added Conditional AOE functionality. This is the ability to create an AOE question dependent on the answer to another AOE question.

Answer Questions for Test: Assigned Test

* Source of Specimen? Fluid

* Type of Fluid? Peritoneal Fluid Abdominal Fluid Pleural Fluid

* Right or Left Lung Right Left

The question 'Type of Fluid' will only appear if the answer to 'Source of Specimen' is 'Fluid' and 'Right or Left Lung' will only appear if the answer to 'Type of Fluid' is 'Pleural Fluid'.

- Added option to allow a user to edit a PID. A field has been added on the Admin Mode / Edit User / Advanced settings tab to turn this on for a user.

Advanced Settings

To enter multiple values in a field, separate the list with commas.

Access Type: By Client Mnemonic By Physician ID Super-User

Allow PID Edit: Do not Allow Allow

- Added option for super-users and multiple client mnemonic users to make Client Mnemonic a possible required field on the Add/Edit Patient screen and added message to alert the user.
- Added paging and search ability to Admin Mode / List Users screen.

- Set the DOB of 12/31/1840 (the value defaulted if no DOB is entered), to not display on the detail result view screen or on the result report.
- Added the ability for a super-user to view all supply orders, but not allow them to order supplies for an office.
- Added link on the Login screen to download the Mead ScriptX Print control.
- Added link on the Login screen to define Labtest as a Trusted Site.
- Added Interface Monitoring functionality to enable the Admin user to view status of the interface and transactions that were sent.
